PAYMENTS - For our international expeditions and treks, payments are generally made by wire transfer in US Dollars. Please contact our office or see the trip notes for our US Dollar Bank account details. We can also accept a bank draft in US Dollars.

A deposit secures your booking and full payment is due 120 days prior to the start date for your trek. We can accept payment of your deposit via Visa or MasterCard. The balance of payment must be through one of the methods mentioned above. We will send you receipts for all payments. All prices are subject to change.

CANCELLATIONS - Once you have paid your deposit your trip is confirmed, subject to payment of the balance of fees owing 120 days prior to your trip commencement date.

- Cancellations outside of 120 days will result in the loss of the trip deposit...
- For cancellations made within 120 days of the trip commencement date we reserve the right to retain 50% of the full fee.
- For cancellations within 90 days of the departure date a cancellation fee of 100% of the full fee applies.
- We recommend you take out trip cancellation insurance via your Travelex Insurance.
